

"You have put joy in my heart, More than [others know] when their wheat and new wine have yielded abundantly. In peace [and with a tranquil heart] I will both lie down and sleep, For You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety and confident trust." Psalm 4:7-8 (AMP)

Introduction: A lot of us might tell people we want them to be happy. We tell our children, our friends, "do what makes you happy." That's a nice sentiment and it's great to wish someone happiness. I'd like you to consider wishing people Joy. Happiness is based on external factors. Joy is internal and consistent. While happiness is a wonderful emotion it's dependent on what "happens". Joy on the other hand, is chosen. It is my prayer that this lesson helps us all choose joy over and over again; that we cultivate it, are unselfish with it, find strength and peace in it, and that it is always in full supply.

★ Salvation and being in God's presence makes His joy available to us. If the Holy Spirit dwells in you, then joy is available to you.

Question: What comes to mind when you think of joy? Where does joy come from? How do you find joy?

Scripture:

 "But the fruit of the Spirit [the result of His presence within us] is love [unselfish concern for others], joy, [inner] peace, patience [not the ability to wait, but how we act while waiting], kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law."

Galatians 5:22-23 (AMP)

- "You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy: At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore"

Question: Have you ever felt joy was beyond your reach? What trials, fears, troubles made you feel this way?

★ Having joy does not make us exempt from feelings of loss, pain, or sorrow. It will bring you comfort in knowing these things pass.

Question: Can you think of moments or situations where joy is intermingled with sadness?

★ Share your joy. Plant seeds of joy in others by comforting them, praying for them, encouraging them, sharing the love of Jesus with them. You may even find your own joy increases.

Question: What are ways we can share and help replenish the joy in others? Has any helped refresh your joy?
